12. The Jury will be composed of 3 professional photographers and two representatives of the Nicaraguan Institute of Culture. The results of the contest will be announced through a Press Release and on the INC website.

13. The winners of the first three places will receive:

a) Diploma of Participation

b) Medal

14. The winners will be contacted by the Regional Representatives of the Nicaraguan Institute of Culture to inform them of the jury's decision.
